IN A RECENT LETTER, 75 LEADING MARINE SCIENTISTS

from institutions including Cornell, Duke, and the New England Aquarium warn that seismic oil and gas surveys off the East Coast are likely to have “significant, long-lasting, and widespread impacts on fish and marine mammal populations.” They urge President Obama to reject the Interior Department’s decision to introduce seismic surveys in the Atlantic.
