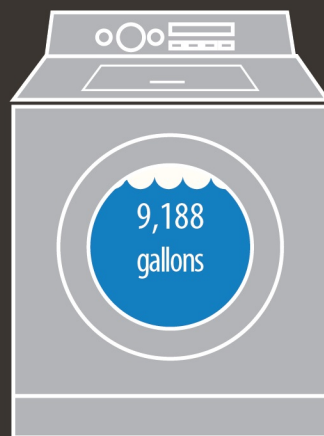

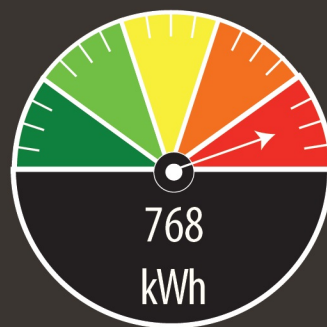

ENERGY STAR USES **35%** LESS WATER THAN STANDARD MACHINES

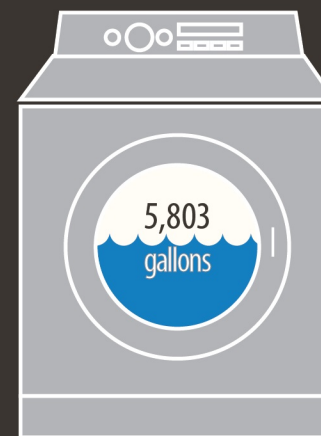
THESE SAVINGS COULD FILL **80 BATHTUBS**

ENERGY STAR USES **35%** LESS ENERGY THAN STANDARD MACHINES

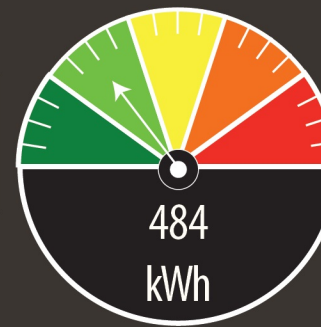
