Dear Dimple and Sarah:

Paragraph 79 of the Settlement Agreement requires CORE teams to conduct Follow-up Visits through December 31, 2018. Between the beginning of the program in January 2016 through October 31, 2018, CORE has conducted 510,321 Initial or Follow-up Visits, which includes 157,919 Completed Visits. In short, the CORE team efforts have been a clear success.

Because Follow-up Visits are no longer required under the Settlement Agreement, pursuant to Paragraph 70 of the Settlement Agreement, State Parties are providing notice that CORE staff will no longer be utilized or employed after December 31, 2018.
