Q1 How likely would you say you are to vote in next year's elections for Congress and other offices: are you certain to vote, will you probably vote, are the chances 50/50, or will you probably not vote?

Q2 Are you familiar with the process used to extract oil and gas called hydraulic fracturing or "fracking," or not?

Q3 Fracking is an industrial process that uses water and chemicals to extract oil and gas from the subsurface.
