Below is the City's response to the EPA action item regarding service line material update. As of August 13, 2021, there have been 27,505 service lines checked with 10,077 replacements. The City currently has 488 signed affidavits to have lines checked. The City also currently have 651 homeowners who have declined to have the City check their line. In the last two weeks before the opt in closure date of July 26, 2021 the City received about 150 more affidavits. The City also has 1578 homeowners who have never responded to any of the notifications sent or delivered to them.
