Below is the City's latest update to the EPA action item regarding service line material update.

As of April 10, 2022, there have been a total of 27,348 service lines checked (5897 in Phase VI) with a total of 10,114 replacements (1735 in Phase VI). In reviewing the past data, it appears that the declinations were added into the service lines checked. Rowe noticed this and corrected their numbers to the City.

Currently there are 388 homes with signed affidavits to have their lines checked. 659 homeowners have declined, and we have 1530 in the City who still have never responded. Now that Rowe will soon be back on board, I expect the number of affidavits to increase slightly as some more people have come forward asking to have their lines checked since December. The City will also continue vetting the latest list sent from the NRDC.
