Dear Ms. Mall,

This letter is in response to your request to confirm that no monitoring documentation exists because implementation of the Gallatin Base Project has not been completed. This project, which is listed in the USDA Forest Service Hazardous Fuels Database, includes the Deer Creek Prescribed Burn project and the Packsaddle Butte Multiple Resource project. As displayed in the Hazardous Fuels Database, approximately 600 acres of mechanical treatment and up to 400 acres of prescribed fire remain to be treated at this time.

The Deer Creek Prescribed Burn project Environmental Assessment and Decision Notice was signed in 1999, with implementation occurring over a 12-year period. The Packsaddle Butte EA/DN was signed in 1998, with implementation occurring over a 6-year period. Julie Shea recently provided information on the monitoring plans for both projects (letter dated 01/15/2003). Post-treatment monitoring has begun on the areas that have been treated to-date. However, conclusive information is not available at this time.

As requested, you will be notified of the monitoring results for these two projects.
