## State bills and the Clean Power Plan April 2016

These bills, introduced during 2016 legislative sessions, include language that aims to obstruct or hinder the Clean Power Plan. <u>As of April 30, 2016, 56% of these bills have failed</u>. Another 34% are pending and likely to expire without passage when state legislatures adjourn this summer.
