Below is the City's response to the EPA action item regarding service line material update. As of December 1, 2021, there have been a total of 27,348 service lines checked (5897 in Phase VI) with a total of 10,114 replacements (1735 in Phase VI).

Currently there are 388 homes with signed affidavits to have their lines checked. 659 homeowners have declined, and we have 1530 in the City who still have never responded.

Currently the asphalt plants have shut down and our contractor has stopped doing line checks/replacements. It looks like we will be done till next spring for the most part. Although we are looking into how to get any emergency work done when it comes up.
